Preterm birth prevention- high risk women pathway



Scope- This guideline applies to singleton pregnancies only

High risk

Previous preterm birth at < 34 weeks gestation and / or previous pregnancy loss at 16-24 weeks gestation.

- * Affected pregnancy =
 - 16-23 week loss not clearly solely due to placental dysfunction or fetal anomaly OR
 - 24-34 spontaneous preterm birth
