



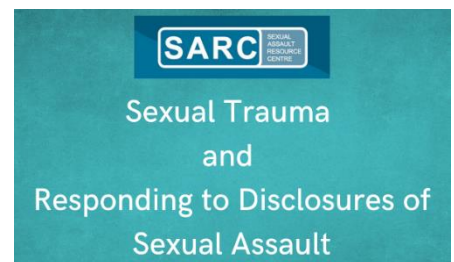
# SARC Education and Training

## E-learning

### Sexual trauma and responding to disclosures of sexual assault

## Online presentations

Delivered using Microsoft Teams

- **Sexual Assault and Responding to Disclosures** – general 1 hour
- **A Trauma Informed Approach to Health Care** – for doctors, nurses, midwives, physios, dentists - 1 hour
- **The Impact of Trauma** - 1 hour
- **Building on Trauma Knowledge** - 1 hour
- **Vicarious Trauma and Self-Care** – 1.5 hours; or 2 x 45 minute presentations if required due to work scheduling

## Face-to-face presentations

- **Sexual Assault and Responding to Disclosures with Skills Rehearsal** - 2 hours
- **Vicarious Trauma and Self-Care** - 2 hours
- **Student Leader training for university student leaders** – 2 hours

Note: a minimum of 10 and maximum of 35 participants required
