Program outline

The Vocational Graduate Diploma of Women's Health (VGDWH) is a nationally recognised training program that was presented for the first time in 2004. Each theme consists of ten evening sessions.

What does the program cover?

The program covers three themes:

1. Family planning and sexual health
14/02/12 - 01/05/12
2. Office gynaecology
15/05/12 - 31/07/12
3. Non-procedural obstetrics
14/08/12 - 30/10/12

Who is the course suitable for?

The program has been designed to cover topics of relevance to non-procedural GPs, GP registrars, junior medical staff from KEMH and other doctors. Midwives and nurses working in women's health as well as practice nurses are also welcome to attend. Video conferencing is available for rural and remote participants.

When and where is the program held?

Vocational Graduate Diploma of Women's Health

In order to attain the VGDWH, participants are required to complete all three themes within two calendar years (attending a minimum of eight out of ten sessions per theme) and satisfactorily complete all assessment requirements. Further information on the assessments is available on request.

- Bleeding in the first half of pregnancy
- Investigation and management of abnormal genital tract bleeding
- Management of benign and malignant diseases of the reproductive organs
- Assessment, investigation and management of a couple with fertility problems
- Urogynaecology 1
 - a) Physiotherapy
 - b) Genital prolapse
- Urogynaecology 2
 - a) Urinary incontinence
 - b) Recurrent urinary tract infections
- Pelvic pain - acute and chronic
- PMS, HRT and alternative management
- Breast disease
- Causes and management of polycystic ovarian syndrome
- Pelvic Inflammatory Disease

The presenters are doctors and other health professionals with expertise in the topic area. The dates for each topic will be confirmed at a later date depending on speaker availability. Part-time participants will be notified of this information prior to the commencement of the course.
