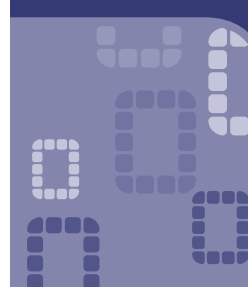

NON-PROCEDURAL OBSTETRICS



Program outline

The Vocational Graduate Diploma of Women's Health (VGDWH) is a nationally recognised training program that was presented for the first time in 2004. Each theme consists of ten evening sessions.

What does the program cover?

The program covers three themes:

1. Family planning and sexual health (2012 TBC)
2. Office gynaecology (2012 TBC)
3. Non-procedural obstetrics

Who is the course suitable for?

The program has been designed to cover topics of relevance to non-procedural GPs, GP registrars, junior medical staff from KEMH and other doctors. Midwives and nurses working in women's health as well as practice nurses are also welcome to attend. At this stage the course is not available by correspondence for participants who are unable to attend in person.

Vocational Graduate Diploma of Women's Health

In order to attain the VGDWH, participants are required to complete all three themes (attending a minimum of eight of ten sessions per theme) and satisfactorily complete all assessment requirements. Further information on the assessments is available on request.

Non-procedural obstetrics: Program topics

- Antenatal Care
 - a) The GP's role and the first visit
 - b) Antenatal and postnatal care for Aboriginal women
- Fetal anomaly screening
Genetic counselling
- Common medical diseases in pregnancy
- The fetus at risk
- Perinatal and maternal mortality
- Use of drugs during pregnancy, lactation and Women and Newborn Drug and Alcohol Service (WANDAS)
- Common infections in pregnancy
- Obstetric problems
 - a) Multiple pregnancy, mal-position and mal-presentation
 - b) Management of bleeding in the second half of pregnancy and use of anti-D
- Birth options and KEMH service(s)
- Postnatal care of mother and baby
- Anxiety and depression in pregnancy and postpartum

The presenters are doctors and other health professionals with expertise in the topic area. The dates for each topic will be confirmed at a later date depending on speaker availability. Part-time participants will be notified of this information prior to the commencement of the course.
