CALCIUM CARBONATE

Unrestricted: Any prescriber may initiate treatment

Presentation	Oral suspension: Calcium Carbonate 500mg/5mL = 100mg/mL Contains: 40mg (1mmol) elemental calcium per mL			
Classification	Calcium supplement			
Indication	Calcium supplementation			
Dose	Enteral nutrition, maintenance requirement			
	Oral: Initial dose: 1mL/ kg/ dose every 12 hours of elemental calcium, increasing up to every 8 hours if needed			
	1mL = 40mg = 1mmol of elemental calcium			
Monitoring	Serum calcium concentration, ionised calcium concentration, phosphate, magnesium, heart rate			
Dose Adjustment	Dose can vary according to calcium intake. Initial required intake is 80-120mg/kg per day.			
, rajueunem	Recommended total daily intake of elemental calcium from all sources: 120mg -200mg per day.

Administration	To be administered via oral route with feeds			
Adverse Reactions	Common	Flatulence, constipation		
	Serious	Gastric hyper-secretion, acid rebound with prolonged use		
Storage	Store at room temperature – below 25°C			

Interactions	Do not mix with any fluids that contain phosphates, carbonates, sulfates or tartrates.		
Notes	 Given in conjunction with buffered sodium phosphate mixture Do not mix with Buffered sodium phosphate mixture, administer at different times Use with caution in neonates who are currently receiving frusemide If intravenous calcium therapy is required refer to calcium gluconate guideline
