<b>Presentation</b>	<p>Oral Solution: Penta-Vite® Multivitamin</p> <p>Each 0.45mL contains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Vitamin A (retinol palmitate)                      390 micrograms</li> <li>○ Vitamin B1 (thiamine HCl)                              540 micrograms</li> <li>○ Vitamin B2 (riboflavine)                                810 micrograms</li> <li>○ Vitamin B (nicotinamide)                                7.1mg</li> <li>○ Vitamin B6 (pyridoxine)                                111.1 micrograms</li> <li>○ Vitamin C (ascorbic acid)                                42.8 mg</li> <li>○ Vitamin D3 (colecalfiferol)                              10.1 microgram</li> <li>○ Sodium saccharin</li> </ul>
<b>Classification</b>	Multivitamin Supplement
<b>Indication</b>	Multivitamin supplement in < 35 weeks gestation on full feeds of unfortified breast milk
<b>Dose</b>	<b>Oral:</b> 0.45mL once a day
<b>Administration</b>	<b>Oral:</b> may be given at any time in regards to feeds
<b>Adverse Reactions</b>	Diarrhoea, nausea
<b>Storage</b>	Store unopened bottle at room temperature Once opened – refrigerate at 2-8°C. Discard 9 weeks after opening
