	IV infusion  Step 1 Reconstitution: as above  Step 2 Dilution: Dilute in 50 - 100 mL with NaCl 0.9%, Hartmann's, Glucose 5% or Glucose 5% in NaCl 0.45%		
	Step 3 Administration: Infuse over 30 to 60 mins
