Presentation

0.5 mL (50 microg) pre-filled syringe (without needle)

Storage

Pre-filled syringes should not be refrozen and should be stored at 2° to 8°C until use.

Dose

<u>Immunisation to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)</u>

IM: Primary course: 2 doses, 8 weeks apart

Booster dose: 1 dose (6 months after last dose or COVID-19 infection, whichever is sooner)

Administration

IM injection into the deltoid muscle

Monitoring

Observe all patients for at least 15 minutes after vaccination

Pregnancy

Bivalent vaccines (Original/Omicron BA.4/5) are the preferred COVID-19 vaccine if you are pregnant, or planning pregnancy

Breastfeeding

Bivalent vaccines (Original/Omicron BA.4/5) are the preferred COVID-19 vaccine if you are pregnant, breastfeeding or planning pregnancy
