Antimicrobial Restriction – Restricted (IV)

Presentation	Vial: 50mg, 70mg			
Dose	Invasive candidiasis			
	IV infusion:			
	≤ 80kg: 70mg IV on the first day, then 50mg IV once daily			
	>80kg: 70mg once daily			
Administration	IV Infusion			
	Step 1 Reconstitution:			
	Allow the vial to reach room temperature. Reconstitute the vial with 10.5mL of sodium chloride 0.9% or water for injections. Mix gently until the powder is dissolved			
	Step 2 Dilution:			
	Dilute the dose in 250mL of sodium chloride 0.9%. If necessary, 100mL can be used for 50mg daily doses			
	Step 3 Administration:			
	Infuse over 1 hour.			
Pregnancy	1 st Trimester: Consider alternative			
	2 nd Trimester: Consider alternative			
	3 rd Trimester: Consider alternative

Breastfeeding	Considered safe to use
