Presentation	Cream: 10%			
	Solution: 1%			
	Vaginal cream: 1% (6 day course)			
	Pessary: 100mg (6 day course)			
	Pessary: 500mg (1 day course)			
Dose	Acute and recurrent Candidiasis			
	1% Vaginal Cream:			
	1 applicatorful intravaginally, once daily at bedtime for 6 nights			
	10% Vaginal Cream:			
	1 applicatorful intravaginally, as a single dose at night			
	100mg Vaginal Pessary:			
	1 pessary intravaginally, once daily at bedtime for 6 nights			
	500mg Vaginal Pessary:			
	1 pessary intravaginally, at bedtime once only			
	Recurrent Candidiasis relapse prevention			
	Clotrimazole 500mg pessary intravaginally, weekly			
	Pregnancy			
	Topical treatment must be used for 12-14 days in pregnancy because of lower response rates and more frequent relapse.			
Administration	In the third trimester of pregnancy extreme caution should be observed when using applicators due to risk of rupturing the membranes.
