Antimicrobial Restriction – Restricted (IV) Pre-approval required by Clinical Microbiologist

Class	Carbapenem antibiotic			
Presentation	Vial: 1g			
Storage	Store at room temperature, below 25°C			
Dose	IV/IM:			
	1g once daily			
Administration	<u>IV:</u>			
	Step 1 Reconstitution:			
	Reconstitute 1g vial with 10mL of WFI or sodium chloride 0.9%			
	Step 2 Dilution:			
	Dilute the reconstituted solution in 50mL of sodium chloride 0.9%			
	Step 3 Administration:			
	Infuse over 30 minutes			
	<u>IM:</u>			
	Step 1 Reconstitution:			
	Reconstitute the 1 g vial with 3.2 mL of lignocaine hydrochloride 1% (without adrenaline). Shake well to dissolve. Do not inject this solution intravenously			
	Step 2 Administration:			
	Inject deep into a large muscle mass			
Pregnancy	1 st Trimester: Consider alternative 2 nd Trimester: Consider alternative	Reports describing the use of ertapenem during pregnancy have not been located. Ertapenem has not been shown to have teratogenic effects in laboratory animals. It
