## **Formulary: Unrestricted**

Class	Anticholinergic					
Presentation	Nebule: 250microg/mL (Aeron®)					
	Metered Dose Inhaler: 21microg/dose (Atrovent®)					
	Nasal Spray: 22microg/dose (Atrovent®)					
Storage	Store at room temperature, below 25°C. Protect from light.					
Dose	COPD or Asthma					
	Inhaled MDI:					
	2-4 inhalations (42-84 micrograms) 3 or 4 times daily					
	Nebulised:					
	250-500 micrograms up to 3 or 4 hourly					
	Severe Acute Asthma					
	Inhaled MDI:					
	8 inhalations (168 micrograms) every 20 minutes for 3 doses, with salbutamol					
	Nebulised:					
	500 micrograms every 20 minutes for 3 doses, with salbutamol					
	<u>Rhinorrhoea</u>					
	Nasal Inhalation:					
	Initially 2-4 sprays (44-88 micrograms) into each nostril 2 or 3 times daily then reduce dose as symptoms improve.					
Administration	<u>Nebulisation</u>					
	Dilute solution for nebulisation to 2-3mL with sodium chloride 0.9%					
	<u>Inhalation</u>					
	Shake well before use. Inhale ONE puff by mouth at a time. Use via					

	spacer if required. Speak to your pharmacist for further details.				
	Do not allow spray from inhaler, nebuliser or nasal spray to come into contact with eyes.				
Pregnancy	1 <sup>st</sup> Trimester: Considered safe to use				
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Trimester: Considered safe to use				
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Trimester: Considered safe to use				
Breastfeeding	Considered safe to use				
Monitoring	Monitor for eye pain or discomfort, blurred vision or visual halos, or difficulty urinating.
