Class	Carbapenem antibiotic			
Presentation	Vial: 500mg, 1g			
Storage	Store at room temperature, below 25°C			
Dose	Severe mixed aerobic and anaerobic infections IV: 0.5 - 1g every 8 hours. Maximum 2g every 8 hours			
	For renal impairment:			
	Creatinine Clearance	Dose frequency		
	26–50 mL/minute	chosen dose every 12 hours		
	10-25 mL/minute	half the chosen dose every 12 hours		
	<10 mL/minute	half the chosen dose every 24 hours		
Administration	IV Injection Step 1 Reconstitution: Reconstitute the 500mg vial with 10mL or the 1g vial with 20 mL of water for injections. Shake well before use. Step 2 Administration: Inject over 5 minutes IV Infusion Step 1 Reconstitution: As above Step 2 Dilution: Dilute the dose with 50 - 200 mL of sodium chloride 0.9% or glucose 5% Step 3 Administration: Infuse over 15 to 30 minutes
