Storage	Store at room temperature, below 25°C				
Dose	<u>Hypertension</u>

	Initially: 25 – 100mg daily in one or two doses				
	Maintenance: 50-100mg once or twice daily				
	<u>Tachyarrhythmia</u>				
	Oral:				
	25-100mg twice daily				
	IV:				
	5 mg (1–2 mg/minute) repeated at 5-minute intervals if necessary, for up to three doses

Pregnancy	1 st Trimester: Considered safe to use				
	2 nd Trimester: Monitoring required				
	3 rd Trimester: Monitoring required
